"Protecting Your Rights"

Persons suffering personal injuries in an accident caused by the careless or wrongful actions of others are VICTIMS. As a victim, you are entitled to basic rights and potential remedies under the law. To preserve a victim's rights, several things in his/her best interest should be considered. When a victim's injuries are severe, family and friends are there to give loving support; but, they can also be critical in gathering important information needed for legal action as well.

The list below serves as an example of what victims or their families can do to help protect and preserve rights in these cases:

- * facilitate any emergency response appropriate for safety and cooperate as needed with police & emergency personnel.
- * seek medical attention if any injury to the victim is suspected.
- * identify others involved & witnesses; **gather their contact info!**
- * in general, do not give voluntary statements to anyone without first consulting an attorney.
- * contact your insurance company to report the event but be wary of them settling any injury claims before consulting with an attorney.
- * if you choose (as we suggest) attorney representation, then select a firm responsive to **your** situation and motivated to serve **your** needs.

JURY DUTY

The right to serve on a jury is protected by State and Federal laws. Many people have sacrificed to protect your rights. Whenever you are called for jury duty, always answer the subpoena. The mere fact that you know someone involved in the process does not necessarily disqualify you as a juror. If you can be fair and reasonable to both sides of the lawsuit, you should always attempt to serve .

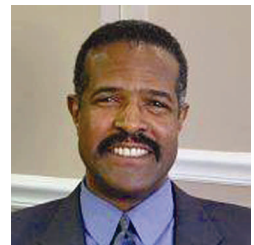

\$1.25 Million Settlement Reached

Attorneys Nathaniel Lee and Laura R. Crowley negotiated a settlement with the qualifying healthcare provider and the Patient Compensation Fund for a total of \$1,250,000.00 in a recent medical negligence case. This is the maximum sum you can collect under Indiana Law.

In this case, the Plaintiffs were the family of a fifty-four (54) year old man who died of pulmonary embolus. The deceased had been hospitalized and released, only to expire a few hours later. None of his various healthcare providers performed testing that would have ruled out this condition as a possible cause for his symptoms and complaints. Ms. Crowley is a Registered Nurse, as well as an attorney, and was able to review the decedent's medical records easily. She concentrates her practice in the areas of medical malpractice.

Verdict for Plaintiff: \$1.15 Million

This fantastic verdict was reached after trying this case for the third time. Attorneys on the case, Nathaniel Lee and John Lowery, worked diligently to see that justice was done. In this case, a large commercial truck was attempting to make a wide right turn into a driveway. The large truck crossed the center line before making its right turn and collided with the Plaintiff's vehicle which was traveling in the right hand lane.

The Plaintiff's injuries were serious, ultimately requiring surgery. Also, she was forced to leave her employment of twenty (20) years and lose valuable retirement benefits. Attorneys Lee and Lowery enlisted the expertise of medical and economic professionals in helping prove their case. Judgments Obtained at 266% of Pre-trial Settlement Offers

Pre-trial settlements of \$24,994 were offered by the defense. The offers were rejected and in all three (3) cases the final verdict exceeded the highest settlement offer made and totaling more than \$66,000.00 - a 166% increase over the pre-trial offers.
