

Macon County Jury Awards Traffic Accident Victim \$1 Million

A Macon County jury awarded the victim of a traffic accident \$1 million on April 25. Bobbie White, 65, was injured, April 23, 1998, in a traffic accident on Rt. 51 and Rt. 50 near Centralia.

White's pickup truck was struck by a car owned by Danka Industries. Its driver went through a stop sign.

White who already had a knee replacement in his left knee at the time of the accident had to undergo two additional surgeries to his left knee after the accident. He had medical bills of over \$92,000.

White is the owner of a salvage yard business in Centralia. His lawyer was William Faber of Decatur.
